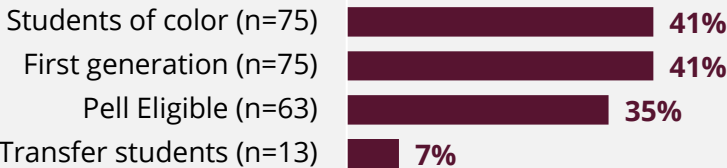
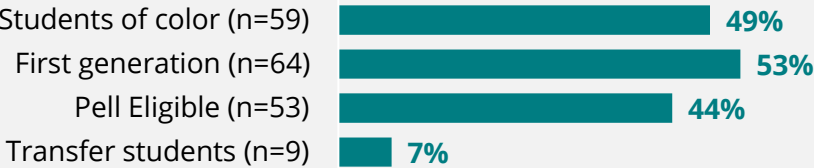
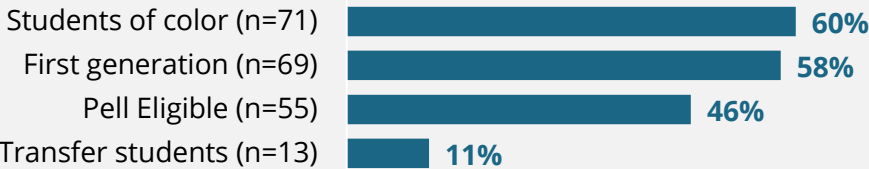

Enhanced practices for tracking engagement and participation with digital sign-in tools.



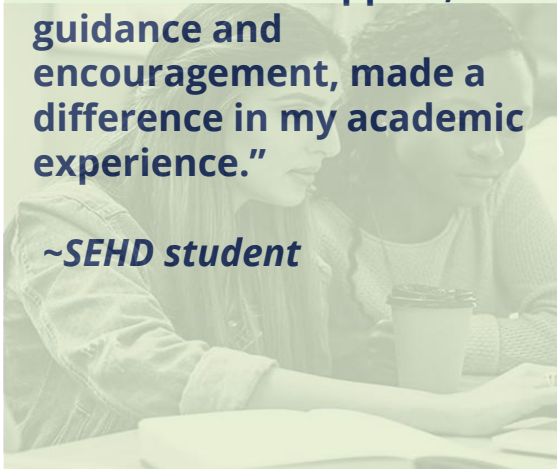
Set the initiative to meet with students on the changes to the Colorado Department of Education competency requirements.



Conducted outreach to all graduate students beyond the Master of Arts in Teaching.

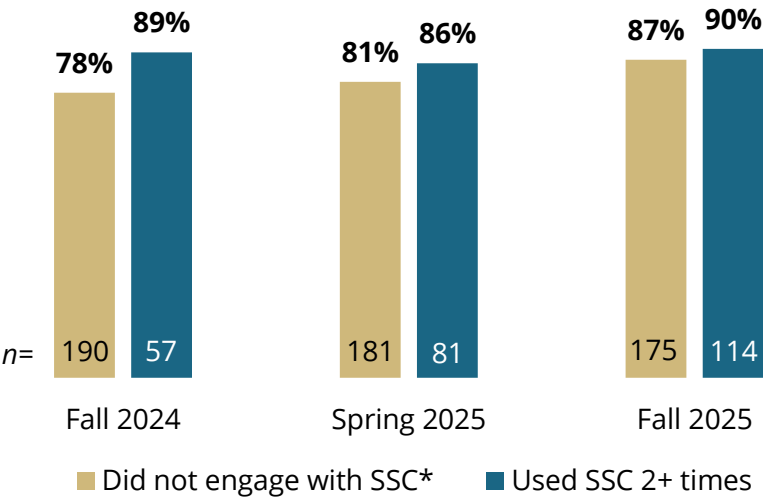

ACADEMIC SUPPORT & TUTORING

Study groups, individual tutoring, course support, writing drop-box, and writing groups

ASYNCHRONOUS SELF-SERVICE DIGITAL RESOURCES

Student Success Center Canvas Shell, TPREP Learning Community Canvas Shell, Steps to Success student onboarding platform, and workshop recordings

EDUCATOR CONTENT COMPETENCY

Praxis requirement support via information sessions, study groups, and individual study plans

COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES

Game days, pancake breakfast, peer events, resource pop-up, class visit, graduation station, and end of semester celebrations

PEER LEADER SUPPORT

Support and guidance from fellow students

DROP-IN SUPPORT HOURS

Flexible virtual times students can connect with success staff

ESSENTIAL RESOURCES

SEHD food pantry, grocery gift cards, clothing exchange, and resource navigation

FINANCIAL FORMS SUPPORT

support with scholarship applications, FAFSA paperwork, and grants

INDIVIDUAL COACHING AND OUTREACH

SSC staff provide targeted individual academic and socioemotional support

NxtGEN community gathering, doctoral student gathering, graduate student gathering, Curious Teacher Symposium, Internship Professional Learning Day, Summer Bridge, and career development sessions
