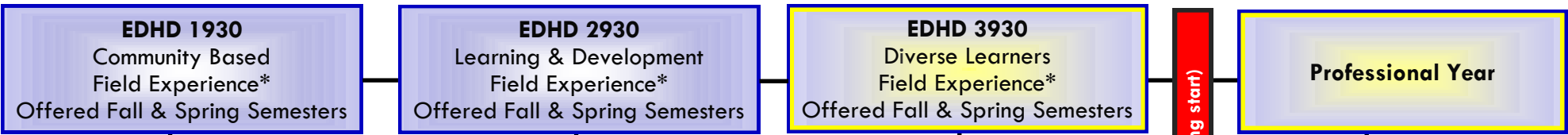


Undergraduate Teacher Education Sequence of Clinical Experiences



***To sign up, complete the Undergrad Early Field Experience Placement Form by: April 15th for fall or summer terms and November 15th for spring term.**

2 Afternoons per week at Community Organization

Seminar
2 hour seminar every other week

Concurrent Courses
EDFN 1000- Equality, Rights & Education

Prerequisites

- At least 1 semester {12 credits}
- Transfers can take the first semester at CU Denver
- EDHD 1930 can be waived with one of the following substitutes (grade of B or better required):
 - EDU 221 Intro to Education (must include Field Experience)
 - UEDU 1930 Pathways to Teaching
 - Teacher Cadet (must have portfolio certificate)

Concurrent Courses
All professional year courses are carefully coordinated with residency internships. Courses are offered in a set schedule as part of the professional year cohort.

Admission into the Professional Year Required (deadlines: February 15th for fall start, October 1st for spring start)

*Blue & yellow boxes = Sequence of Clinical Experiences for both EDHD and CLAS students

All Clinical Block Field Experiences and PDS Residency Internships must be completed in CU Denver Professional Development Schools or Community Partner Network Organizations



Undergraduate Teacher Education Steps to Professional Year

Step 1: Complete the Education Declaration Form

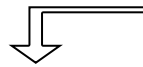
This form is used to add the Education codes to your degree plan.



Step 2: Background Check Assurance Form (<https://goo.gl/Q72pcL>)

START FINGERPRINT PROCESS ASAP!!! (<https://goo.gl/sYBBuK>)

The Background Check form lets the Office of Partnerships know that you have completed the required fingerprint and Oath and Consent questions.



Step 3: Complete the Undergraduate Early Field Experience Placement Form (<https://goo.gl/9Zofvr>)

The Placement form lets the Office of Partnerships know what field experience you are seeking. You need to complete this form for every clinical block you need to take.



Step 4: Undergraduate Teacher Education Orientation

If this is your first clinical experience, you will need to attend an orientation. Dates will be sent out after you complete the Undergraduate Early Field Experience Placement Form.

**Step 5: Complete all of your clinical blocks
(field experiences and concurrent coursework)**

Step 6: Apply for Professional Year
deadlines: March 1st for fall start, October 1st for spring start

Step 7: Take the Praxis II.
Scores must be turned in before your final semester.

Step 8: Apply to graduate
